SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

Edison Lutheran Church was founded in 1902 by Scandinavian immigrants; many of their descendants continue to worship here along with numerous others who appreciate a welcoming, nurturing, and caring faith community. Edison Lutheran is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America (ELCA) which is a community of faith that shares a passion for positive changes in our world. This passion for change and concern for others form the foundation beneath the following scholarships, each subject to the rules and restrictions listed below.

Application is open to any member of Edison Lutheran Church, or to any person closely related to the congregation*, who wishes to further his/her education beyond high school. With the exception of the Thelma Woll Jones Memorial Scholarship, applicants may further their studies at a school and in a field of their choice.

All applications, on the attached form, will be due April 15, 2023. Selection will be made on or before May 15, 2023. Each scholarship may be awarded to one individual or divided among several applicants, as determined by the Edison Lutheran Church Scholarship Review Committee. Scholarships may be granted to pursuing a post-high school or post-baccalaureate degree program.

*determination as to whether a person is 'closely related to the congregation' shall be made in each individual case by the Scholarship Review Committee.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE for 2023-2024 School Year

Edison Lutheran Church Scholarship

The ELC Scholarship is given each year to a student who exemplifies the mission and vision of the church who has been active in the church for at least one year prior to application. The amount of up to \$2000 will be awarded directly to the college in August- October 2023.

Gundersen/Omdal Scholarship

The Gundersen/Omdal Scholarship is given each year to a student who exemplifies the mission and vision of the church within the community. The amount of \$2000 will be awarded directly to the college in August- October 2023.

Lucille Peterson Scholarship

The Lucille Peterson is given each year to a student who wishes to further his/her education. The amount of \$1000 will be awarded directly to the college in August - October 2023.

Theresa Walter Scholarship

The Theresa Walter Scholarship is given each year to a student who exemplifies the mission and vision of the church. The amount of \$1000 will be awarded directly to the college in August- October 2023.

Thelma Woll Jones Scholarship

The Thelma Woll Jones Scholarship is given each year to a student who has a plan to attend a school to earn a degree in either the education or medical field. The amount of \$2000 will be awarded directly to the college September or October 2023.
